On our journey here from Kenya, we were able to spend a couple of days in Scotland. The 60° temperature change from Nairobi to Glasgow was a real shock on our systems, and we did not have coats (our coats stay in Delaware because we never need them in Kenya). We arrived in Philadelphia safely and were met by family. We have enjoyed getting reacquainted with Dr Pepper, Ruffles, American cheese, Subway, and Wal-Mart. Also, it has been a blessing to see our family, friends, and church family at First Baptist Church of Milford, Delaware.

In January, we started traveling to report back to our churches, and have encountered -12°, ice, lots of snow, and WE are **COLD!!!** Please remember us in your prayers as we continue to travel and reacquaint ourselves with each of you.
